

Bruce Peninsula Trip

October 4 to 6, 2019

Join Martina Furrer, David Royle, Brenda Menezes and Wayne Crockett for three days of guided hiking on the beautiful Bruce Peninsula. We will explore the Cape Crocker, Hope Bay, and Lion's Head areas. Hikes will be up to 15 km (no dropouts) with lots of fabulous views. Expect some strenuous climbs, some challenging footing over boulders and crevasses, and some exposed sections. These hikes are not suitable for people who are afraid of heights. All fit, experienced hikers comfortable walking on level three terrain at a level two pace are welcome. We will stay at [Evergreen Resort](#) in Red Bay, overlooking Lake Huron.

Travel direct from Toronto in a luxury highway coach. Our bus departs at 7 am on Friday October 4th and returns around 8 pm on Sunday October 6th. Departure and drop-off location is York Mills subway station.

Accommodation is in one-, two-, and three-bedroom cottages and costs \$255 + HST and gratuity per person. This includes two nights' accommodation, two dinners, two breakfasts, and two boxed lunches.

Coach fare is \$125 for Toronto Bruce Trail Club members and \$145 for non-members.

Registration instructions:

Registration starts on Sunday June 2. Read and follow the instructions carefully. Book your cottage and your seat on the bus on the same day.

1. Call Evergreen Resort at 519-534-1868 to book your cottage. You will need to find roommates/cottagemates. There are no single hotel rooms.
2. To reserve your seat on the coach, complete the [Bruce Peninsula hiking trip registration form](#) and pay your coach fare by sending an e-transfer to martinabeatrice@hotmail.com.

Cancellation policy:

While we are hoping for sunshine, the trip cannot be cancelled due to weather. Coach fare is nonrefundable after August 4th 2019. If you cancel before this date you will be charged a \$25 service fee (donation to the Bruce Trail Conservancy).
